Indefinite adjective meaning: Indefinite adjectives function as adjectives. That is, indefinite adjectives modify nouns and pronouns. Indefinite adjectives are called such because they modify nouns a non-specific or vague manner. Most adjectives give a "definite" modification for nouns. Indefinite adjectives do not.
