Maintain safe clearances from electrical power lines and apparatus. You must allow for platform sway, rock or sag.

Scissor Lift Safety, How to Operate a Scissor Lift

Scissor lifts must have guardrails installed around the perimeter of the work platform, and regular maintenance is essential to ensure they don't rust or loosen. Workers should only stand on the work platform, never on the guardrails, and work should be kept close to the scissor lift to avoid having workers lean over the edge of the rails.
